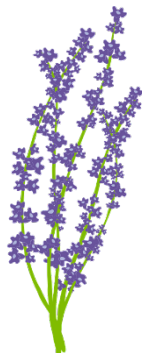

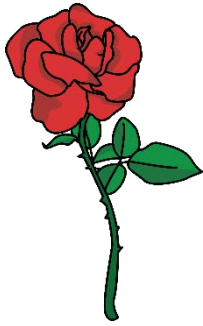

Can you describe your wedding bouquet (or anyone else's)?

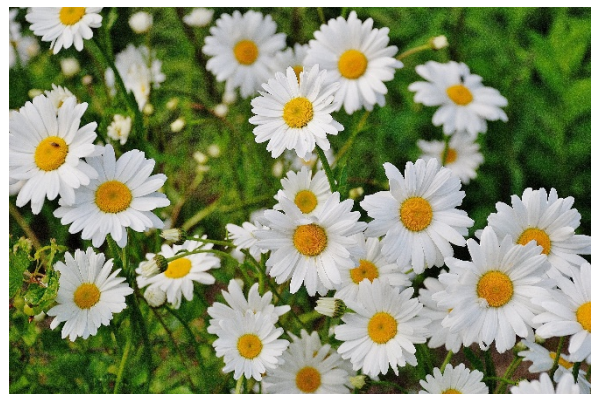
What was your mother's favourite flower? Is your the same?
