Talk and reminiscence

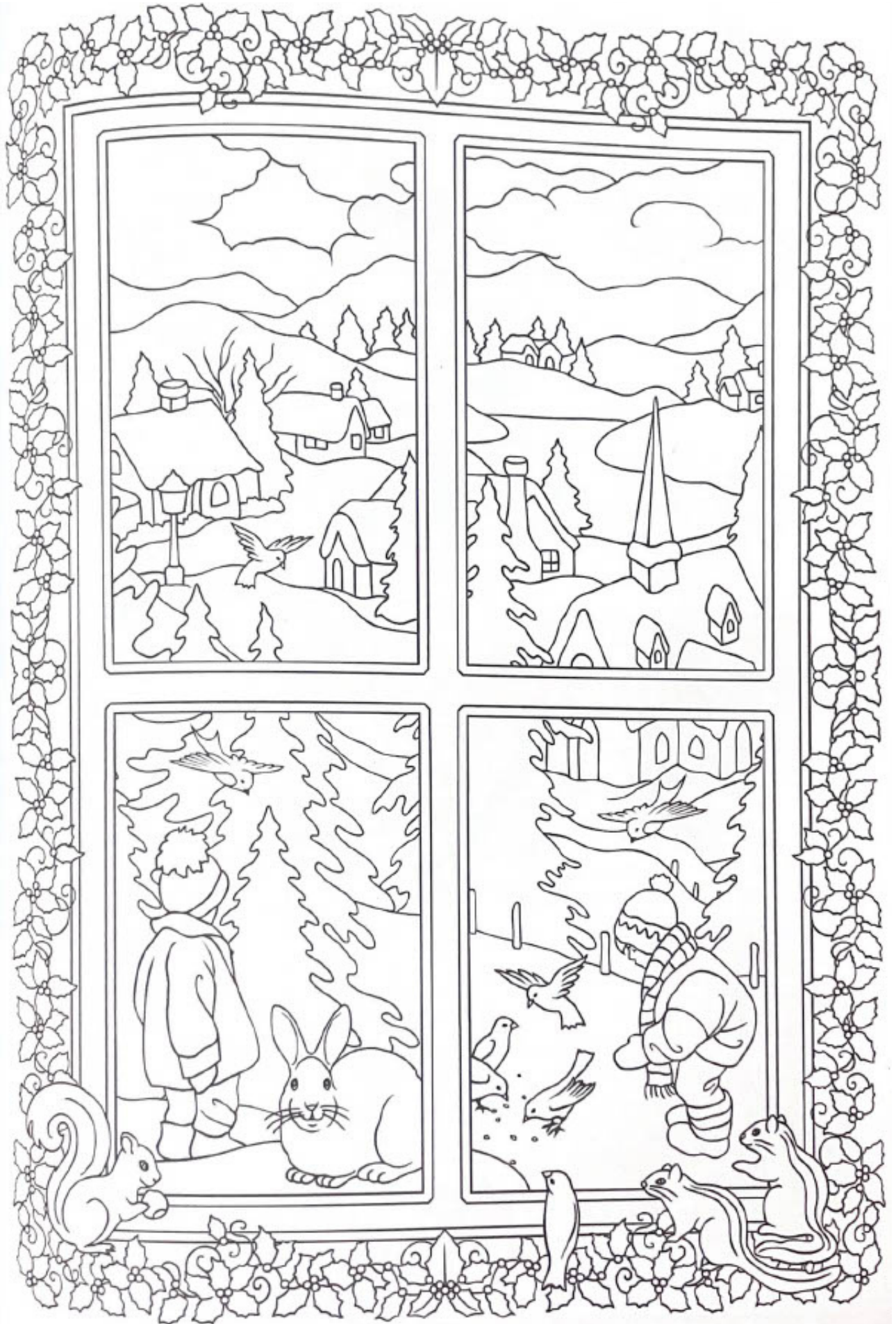
Theme: Holiday cheer

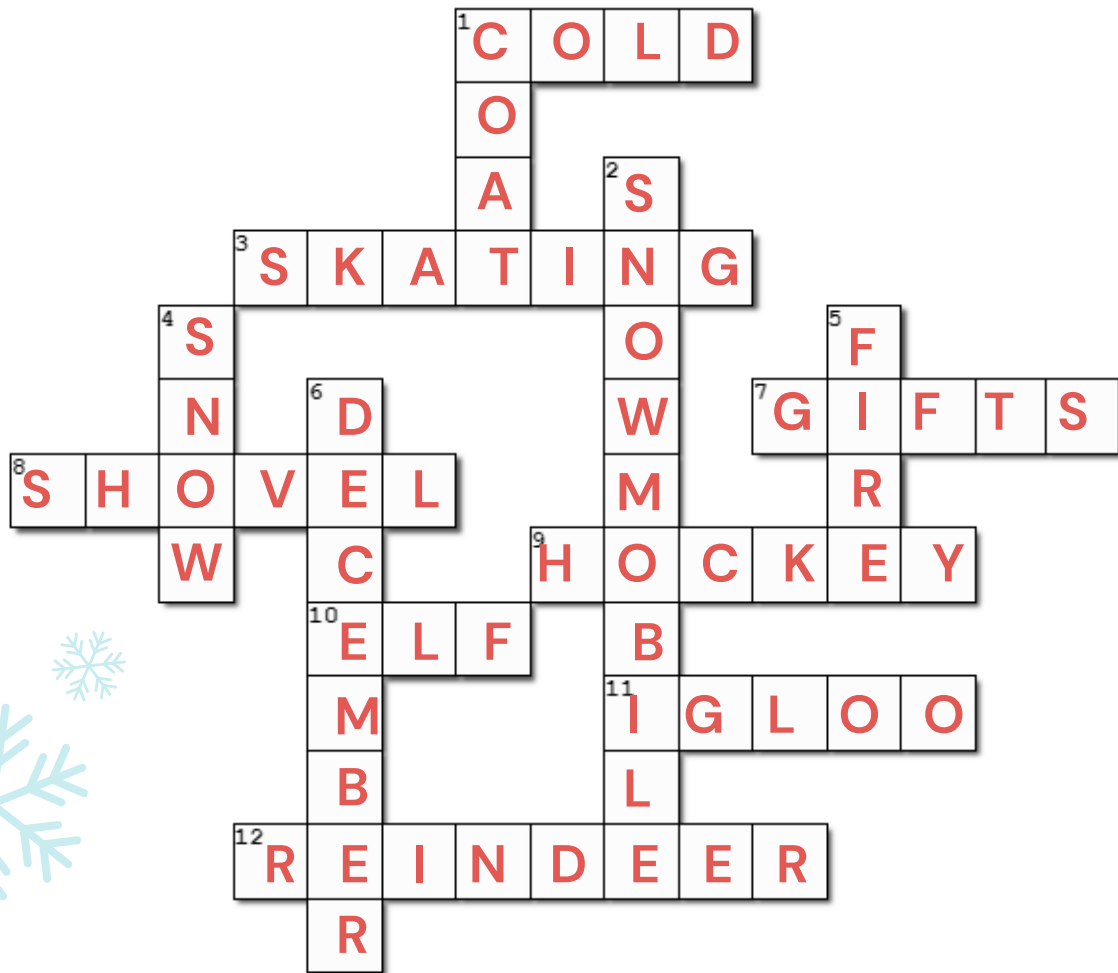
