# Talk and reminiscence

Theme: Winter memories

(Homemade soup, pies, Christmas desserts...)
- **Is there a funny or unexpected winter moment that you still remember today?**
- **What winter gift or surprise made the biggest impression on you?**  
(Childhood, adolescence, or adulthood.)
- **What has changed the most in today's winters compared to those of your youth?**  
(Snow, traditions, pace of life, decorations...)

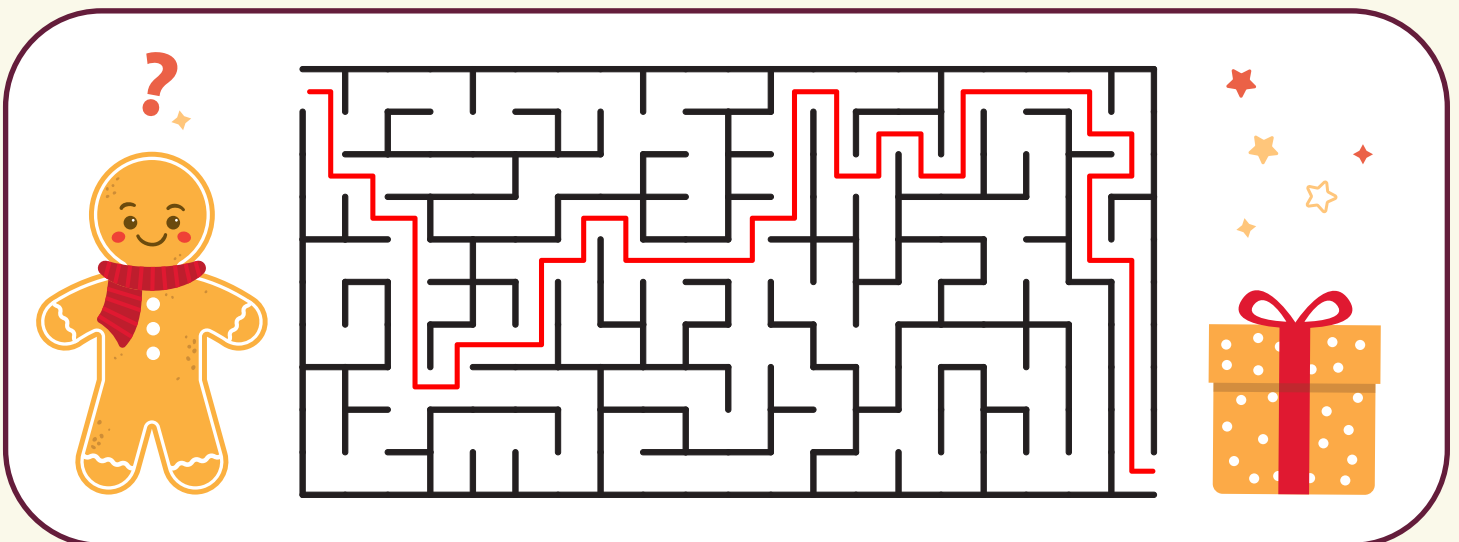
