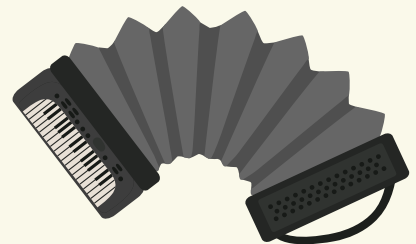
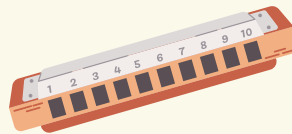

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Talk and reminiscence

Theme: Winter memories

This activity is designed to encourage communication between participants. You'll be given different themes that will spark discussion across the group and bring back memories for everyone. You can read the questions or sentences out loud, and then initiate a group discussion!

- **What winter item** (mittens, scarf, boots, etc.) **reminds you most of your youth? Why?**
- **Do you have a vivid memory of a winter journey—on foot, by train, by car, or by sleigh?**
- **How was your home or neighborhood decorated for the holidays when you were young?**
- **What was the sound of winter for you?**
(The wind, crunching snow, songs, bells...)
- **Was there someone you particularly enjoyed spending winter with?**
(A friend, neighbor, family member...)
- **Have you ever had a crazy or unexpected winter adventure?**
(Getting lost in the snow, sliding too fast, a power outage...)
- **What was your favorite place in winter?** (A corner of the neighborhood, a pond, the kitchen, the mountains...)
- **What winter tradition would you like to see again today, even if it has disappeared?**

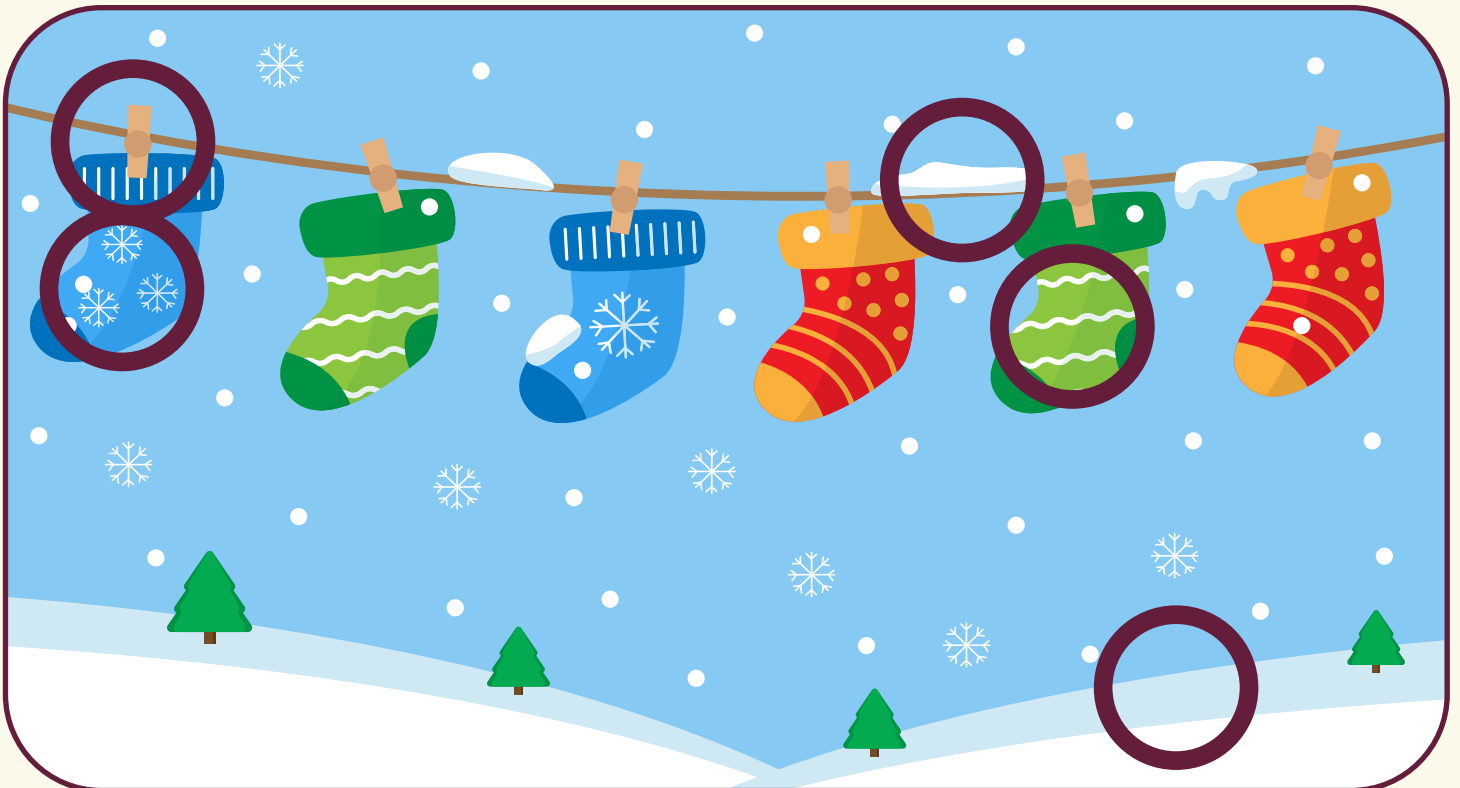
