Talk and reminiscence

Theme: Winter memories

This activity is designed to encourage communication between participants. You'll be given different themes that will spark discussion across the group and bring back memories for everyone. You can read the questions or sentences out loud, and then initiate a group discussion!

- **Do you remember a particularly mild or particularly cold winter that made an impression on you?**
- **Did you have a tradition for celebrating the New Year?**
(A special meal, an outing, a family superstition...)
- **What is a little winter pleasure that you still enjoy today?**
